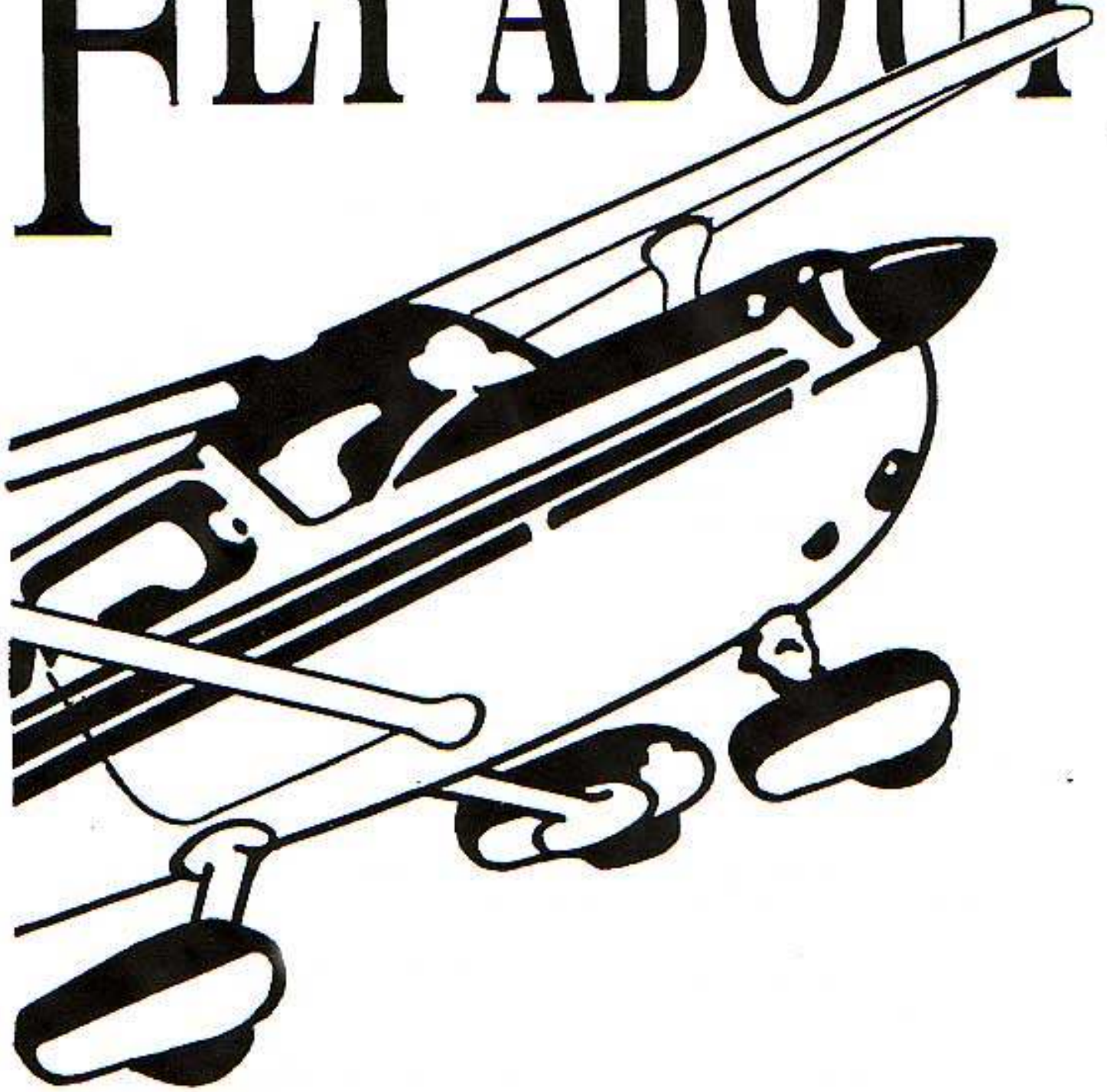

Earth Rounder visits Northam

Northam aviators were honoured in January with a visit by Mooney round-the-world veteran CarolAnn Garratt.

CarolAnn, on her third circumnavigation in her Mooney J-model MSE, stopped over in Northam for repairs and R & R under the stewardship of Claude Meunier, Northam resident and founder of Earthrounders, the organisation that supports and records flights around the world in small aircraft.

For someone who has achieved more than the rest of us put together, CarolAnn is disarmingly modest and self-deprecating. She sees her epic flights more as successful examples of thorough planning than derring-do or particular skill on her part. I beg to differ, and see her as a pioneering role model for all – particularly women – who fly the Mooney marque.

We met at Northam Airport, where LAME Ian Bristow-Stagg sorted out undercarriage problems that had plagued N220FC since Kuala Lumpur. CarolAnn had to fly with wheels half-retracted, which reduced her speed by 15-20 knots, all the way to Northam.

She was pretty philosophical about this, and some other minor problems, but was happy that everything was put right with a minimum of fuss. Just as well, because her boyfriend, Heinrich, was arriving from Germany a couple of days later to share a quick tour of Uluru and Tasmania before CarolAnn departed solo for Hawaii and her home in Orlando, Florida.

CarolAnne dropped in the club to share her experiences with anyone who had a question to ask. You'd never have imagined that this gracious, friendly woman had conquered some of the toughest summits in the topography of aviation.

CarolAnn made her first round-the-world flight – solo – in 2003. Five years later she was off again, this time with a co-pilot, to set a world record and raise funds to find a cure for motor neurone disease, of which her mother died in 2002. The pair completed the flight in seven days! This time she's solo again, and enjoying a more relaxed schedule.
